

Bosnia and Herzegovina solar power project

Will Bosnia and Herzegovina build a new hydropower plant?

As well as new coal capacity, Bosnia and Herzegovina plans a large amount of new hydropower, which is proving even more controversial than the coal plants. In the last decade, more than 100 small hydropower plants have been built, causing widespread public resistance in places like Fojnica, Kruscica and on the Neretvica and Buna.

Which sector produces res energy in Bosnia and Herzegovina?

Production of RES energy in Bosnia and Herzegovina is dominated by the heating and cooling sector, for which an increase from the baseline 867.2 ktoe to 1085.2 ktoe in 2020 was planned. In addition, the share of electric energy sector in production of RES energy in the planned period increases from the baseline 444.2 ktoe to 760.6 ktoe in 2020.

How much does electricity cost in Bosnia & Herzegovina?

Bosnia and Herzegovina, March 2023: The price of electricity is 0.097 U.S. Dollar per kWh for households and 0.110 U.S. Dollar for businesses which includes all components of the electricity bill such as the cost of power, distribution and taxes.

How many projects have been implemented in Bosnia & Herzegovina?

More than 540 projects were implemented in the fields of public health, shelter, water, energy, public transport, communications, education and sanitation. The Trust Fund for the Police Assistance Programme in Bosnia and Herzegovina received contributions of \$16.3 million.

Should Bosnia and Herzegovina use more energy?

Bosnia and Herzegovina could do a lot more to use energy efficiently. Electricity prices are kept artificially low and there is therefore limited incentive to make savings. The country is almost four times as energy-intensive as the average in EU countries and has the highest energy intensity in the Western Balkans.

How much heat energy will Bosnia and Herzegovina produce in 2020?

The planned trajectory for the heating and cooling sector in Bosnia and Herzegovina shows that production of heat energy from RES in 2020 would be 1085.2 ktoe, which represents an increase in production of renewable heat energy by 279.4 ktoe compared to the baseline year.
