Do solar PV panels need to be cleaned?

That said, most solar pv panels in the UK will not need any heavy-duty cleaning because regular rain will wash most dirt and grime off the surface, dispelling one of the myths about solar being its difficulty to clean.

How do you clean solar panels with water?

When cleaning your panels with water, use a standard garden hose and soapy water. You don't need to purchase any particular cleaning solution to clean your panels; regular dish soap will work perfectly. Avoid any strong cleaning agents like bleach that could damage your panels.

Can rainwater clean solar panels?

While rainwater can help to clear off dust, it isn't the best way to clean solar panels. When rainwater evaporates, it can leave rings of dust and debris, which will affect how efficiently the panels produce solar power.

Can you clean solar panels in summer?

Summer is still possible to clean solar panels but is less than ideal. This is because using a hose pipe to spray cold water on the panels in hot weather may potentially damage them, so on these occasions it is best to do this in the early morning or in the evening.

Can a solar panel take water from a pressure washer?

Solar panels are not designed to take the impact of a high pressure stream of water from a pressure washer. Furthermore, a grid-connected solar panel array with solar batteries is a high voltage electrical system which is potentially dangerous if it is damaged. Doing this will therefore almost certainly invalidate the warranty.

Do solar panels need to be cleaned after a downpour?

Whether you have a rigid rooftop array or a series of portable solar panels, it's best to keep cleaning to a bare minimum. While rooftop panels should be fine after a downpour, call a cleaning service if in doubt. For your portable panels, keep it simple with water, and a soft cloth.
