

Does Cyprus have a lot of sunshine?

Sunshine is present all year round in Cyprus, even in the winter. On average one should expect between five and seven hours of sunshine per day during the winter and up to eleven to twelve hours of sunshine during summer. Especially during summer, sunshine is continuous and bright, even small clouds are rarely seen during summer months.
