

Can I install solar panels myself?

You can install solar panels on your home yourself. You will need some electrical wiring experience, and we suggest that you also use a professional solar contractor or electrician to do the wiring and connection processes to ensure that you: Do not start an electrical fire that damages or destroys your home, solar array, and solar components.

How are solar panels wired?

There are multiple ways to approach solar panel wiring. One of the key differences to understand is stringing solar panels in series versus stringing solar panels in parallel. These different stringing configurations have different effects on the electrical current and voltage in the circuit.

How do you wire solar panels in series?

Wiring solar panels in series involves connecting each panel to the next in a line (as illustrated in the diagram above). Just like a typical battery that you may be familiar with, solar panels have positive and negative terminals.

What is a solar PV system?

Do I need an electrician to install solar panels?

How to wire solar panels in parallel or series?

Connect the negative terminal of the first panel and the positive terminal of the second panel and connect to the corresponding terminals in solar regulator's input. The solar regulator will detect the panels and start to charge the battery during sunlight. Wiring solar panels in parallel or series doesn't have to be an either/or proposition.
