

Who manages the power sector in Norway?

The Ministry of Petroleum and Energy has overall responsibility for managing the power sector in Norway. The legislation for security of electricity supply and emergency preparedness is outlined in Chapter 9 of the Energy Act and the Regulation on Security and Emergency Preparedness in the Power Supply System.

What if power and water supplies collapse in Norway?

The goal is for all Norwegians to be able to take care of themselves for up to a week, if power and water supplies collapse. "We're launching updated preparedness advice to the entire population," said Elisabeth Aars, leader of Norway's state Directorate for Security and Preparedness DSB (Direktoratet for sikkerhet og beredskap).

Why is emergency preparedness important in Norway?

The introduction makes this clear: "If a larger part of the population is able to take care of themselves and those around during an emergency, immediate help is more likely to reach those who need it most first. In this way, you make a part of Norway's emergency preparedness."

Is Norway launching updated preparedness advice?

"We're launching updated preparedness advice to the entire population," said Elisabeth Aars, leader of Norway's state Directorate for Security and Preparedness DSB (Direktoratet for sikkerhet og beredskap). "This is an important message that we want folks to pay attention to."

What is the continuity of electricity supply in Norway?

The continuity of the electricity supply depends on both the frequency and the duration of interruptions in the supply. In Norway, continuity of supply is stable and very good, and is close to 99.99 % in years without extreme weather events. It has never dropped below 99.96 % in any year since 1996, see the figure below.

Does Norway have a good power system?

Norway has a sound power balance and high power trading capacity, and therefore enjoys high energy security in the power system. Nevertheless, low water inflow and events outside Norway can make the situation difficult at times. Statnett is responsible for developing measures to deal with highly strained power situations energy situations.

In Norway, emergency medical treatment is provided by hospitals and emergency medical centers. In case of a life-threatening emergency, the best option is to call the emergency medical services (EMS) by dialing 113. The EMS will dispatch an ambulance to the location of the emergency and transport the patient to the nearest hospital.

In an emergency, you can contact the police in Norway by calling 112. For all non-emergency queries, contact the police central switchboard on 02800. The emergency number should be used to report criminal offences where there is a danger to life. It should also be used if there is a risk of evidence being destroyed. Read more: Crime in Norway

Still, life in Norway depends on power, water supply and the internet, which in turn makes us vulnerable. Storms, natural disasters, sabotage, technical problems, terrorism or acts of war could result in power outage or a cut-off of water supply. In a state of emergency, it may also be difficult to get hold of essential goods.

Emergency passports can in certain cases be issued at the embassy. The information on the personal information page is written by hand in emergency passports. Note! Emergency passports cannot be used for entry to some countries, e.g. USA. The emergency passport costs more than an ordinary passport.
