Are solar panels toxic?

Although it is true that some solar panels contain metals that are considered toxic in large quantities, it is very rare for humans to become exposed to these elements at any point in the equipment life cycle. In the best interest of our customers and the planet, PPM does not install solar panels manufactured with toxic materials.

Can solar panels be installed on a building roof?

Solar energy brings many positives from a climate change perspective, but installing solar PV panels on building rooftops can introduce new risks to the building and occupants. Fires resulting from electrical faults is the most common cause of loss associated with roof mounted solar PV installations.

Do solar panels cause cancer?

For decades, studies have been performed to conclude that there are no associations between solar energy and cancer. True for rooftop installations and large solar farms, global public health researchers have found that solar panels do not cause cancer at any production level.

Can a solar panel fire damage a building?

Planning and design issues can also add to the risk of solar panel fires, causing damage to not just the PV installation, but the building on which they are mounted. An example of this would be a PV system being installed on a combustible/partially combustible roof, with no fire-resistant covering.

Does ppm install solar panels made with toxic materials?

In the best interest of our customers and the planet, PPM does not install solar panels manufactured with toxic materials. Instead, we use LED-free equipment without the Cadmium Telluride sometimes found in modern solar panels. Even further, we do not install high-voltage DC systems in residential neighborhoods.

Are thin film solar panels dangerous?

Thin-film panels are not common for residential solar installations and are most often used in large commercial or utility-scaled applications. While these chemicals can be considered hazardous, they aren't so while the panels are on your roof.
