

Can solar energy replace fossil fuels on Pitcairn Island?

Pitcairn's authorities have launched a renewable energy project designed to replace fossil fuels with solar energy. The goal is to replace 95% of the current diesel consumption on Pitcairn Island (75,000 liters per year) with a combination of energy saving and solar electricity through the installation of a hybrid photovoltaic solar energy system.

Are the Pitcairn Islands Green?

Pitcairn Islands, a group of five islands with a total area of 47 km<sup>2</sup> and which constitute one of the most remote archipelagos in the world, turn to safer, greener energies that best meet the needs of the population. Pitcairn's authorities have launched a renewable energy project designed to replace fossil fuels with solar energy.

Who manages Pitcairn Islands tourism?

In December 2010 the Government of Pitcairn Islands established its Tourism Department. Previously Pitcairn's tourism initiatives were managed by a voluntary group known as the Pitcairn Island Tourism Board.

Where are the Pitcairn Islands located?

The Pitcairn Islands are located in the central South Pacific, almost exactly midway between New Zealand and Peru. They are positioned between longitudes 131°; and 124°;W and latitudes 23°; and 26°;S. Access is by sea only.

What is the climate of the Pitcairn Islands like?

The climate of the subtropical oceanic Pitcairn Islands is expected to experience a temperature increase of 0.5-0.7°C (RCP2.6) to 2.50-3.0°C (RCP8.5) by 2100 relative to the 1985-2005 baseline period (Collins et al., 2013). Based upon the absence of large landmasses and the islands' latitude, shallow water sea temperatures are expected to rise.

What is the extent of the CCA around Pitcairn?

The CCA around Pitcairn extends 40 nm to the southeast in a tapering triangle shape and then encloses Adam's Seamount (known locally as 40 Mile Reef) with a 2 nm radius. The reason for designating the tapering triangular shape is to allow Pitcairners the opportunity to undertake trolling during the journey to/from 40 Mile Reef.

Discovery of Pitcairn Island . Captain Philip Carteret first spotted Pitcairn Island in 1767 but couldn't land due to rough seas. He miscalculated its location, marking it miles away from its true position. Years later, Captain Cook showed some interest, but it wasn't until the Bounty mutineers arrived in 1790 that the island gained attention.

The Government of Pitcairn Island partners (GPI) acted swiftly to close the island's border in March 2020, when the COVID-19 (C-19) pandemic spread around the world. GPI recognises that the pandemic will continue to impact Pitcairn's visitor economy, essential travel to and from the island and the secondary health
