

How much solar energy will Qatar have by 2024?

If these solar energy projects come online as expected, about 13% of Qatar's electricity generation capacity will come from solar energy by the end of 2024, with solar capacity totalling 1780 MW out of a total generating capacity of 12 GW.

What is Qatar's Solar Energy Future?

Qatar's solar energy future is steadily developing. With average daily sunshine of around 9.5 hours, low-cloud cover conditions and plentiful space, there is great scope for small, medium as well as large-scale solar power projects in the country.

Does Qatar need solar energy?

On the renewable energy front, Qatar aims for solar energy to constitute 30% of its electricity-generation capacity by 2030. In October 2022 the country's first solar-PV energy project, the 800-MW Al Kharsaah power plant, started operating and now supplies around 10% of domestic peak energy consumption needs.

How many solar PV projects are there in Qatar?

The installed capacity of solar power generation in Qatar was recorded as 5.1 MW, as of 2020, which is far from the required targets to have a considerable share of renewables in the energy mix. Thus umpteen solar PV projects are lined up to boost the capacity in the nation.

Why should Qatar invest in solar energy?

Solar energy has multiple advantages for Qatar in the form of energy security, improved air quality, reduced GHG emissions, employment opportunities, apart from augmenting water and food security.

How much energy does Qatar produce?

The International Renewable Energy Agency stated that Qatar's total domestic energy supply in 2020 consisted of 91% gas and 9% oil, with only 0.02% of the country's energy produced from renewable sources.
