What is the optimal tilt angle of photovoltaic solar panels?

The optimal tilt angle of photovoltaic solar panels is that the surface of the solar panel faces the Sun perpendicularly. However, the angle of incidence of solar radiation varies during the day and during different times of the year.

What is the best angle for solar panels in the UK?

The best all-year-round angle for PV (photovoltaic) solar panels in the UK is 35-40 degrees. The best angle for each region within the UK will vary slightly within this.
