

Do employers have to provide lockers?

Employers don't necessarily have to provide employees with storage lockers, however, a space to change and store clothing is required if staff members need to get changed on-site.

What is a locker & why do you need one?

Lockers can form part of a changing room complex, or be used throughout a facility to provide security and storage for personal effects or work equipment. Providing lockers can often help to reduce petty criminal actions within a facility such as theft or vandalism.

Do you need a safety locker?

If you are required to wear safety clothing or use safety equipment, or perhaps PPE for the role, then a locker may also be required. Metal lockers can be fitted with a steel sheet divider to keep personal clothing separate from soiled workwear, and shelves can be included for PPE, bags and personal belongings.
